Notice Concerning Copyright Law and Photocopy Restrictions

- The copyright law of the United States (Title 17, United States Code) governs the making of photocopies or other reproductions of copyrighted material. Under certain conditions specified in the law, libraries and archives are authorized to furnish a photocopy or other reproduction. One of these specified conditions is that the photocopy or reproduction is not to be used “for any purpose other than private study, scholarship, or research.” If a user makes a request for, or later uses, a photocopy or reproduction for purposes in excess of “fair use,” that user may be liable for copyright infringement.
- This institution reserves the right to refuse to accept a copying order if, in its judgment, fulfillment of the order would involve violation of copyright law.
- Requests for photocopies of material will be considered when duplication can be made without injury to the material, when it is within Georgia Historical Society policy, and when it is in accordance with donor agreements and copyright law. When allowed, single copies will be provided for the requestor’s reference use only.
- In providing photocopies, the Georgia Historical Society (GHS) does not grant permission to reproduce or publish. Requests for permission to publish *must be submitted in writing* to GHS. When GHS grants use permission, copyright permission is only granted for materials in which GHS holds copyright. When GHS does not hold copyright, the requestor must obtain copyright permissions separately from the copyright holder. The requestor assumes full responsibility for any infringement of copyright or publication rights belonging to the author, his/her heirs, or assignees.
